

Scilipoti provides Street's voice on accounting rules

The Street has a new voice on accounting rules, as **Veritas Investment Research** co-founder **Anthony Scilipoti** joins the Canadian Institute of Chartered Accountants' standards board.

Mr. Scilipoti and partners that include veteran analyst **Michael Palmer** started **Veritas** 11 years ago, and **Mr. Scilipoti** made his name for helping unravel the most tangled of financial statements. He is executive vice president of the Toronto-based firm, with a research focus on special situations.

At the CICA, **Mr. Scilipoti** will be the only investment industry representative on the nine-member accounting standards board.
